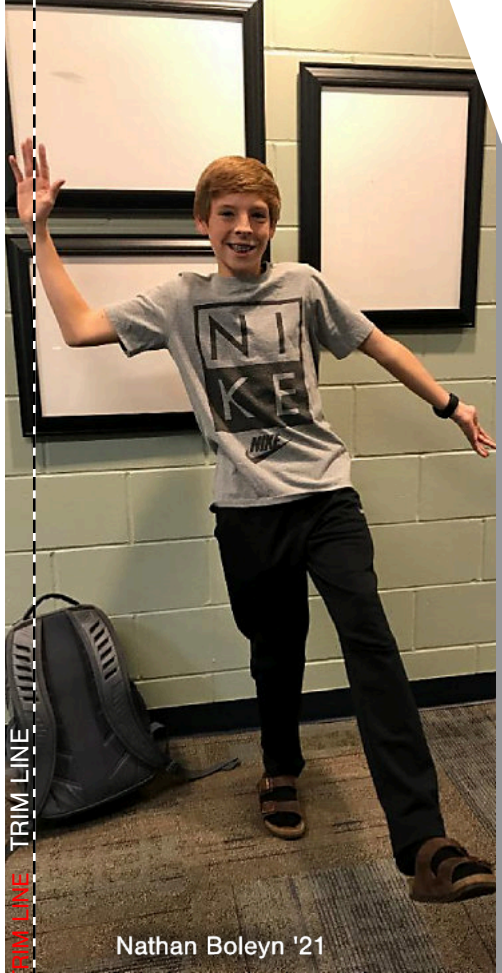


# Are you trending?

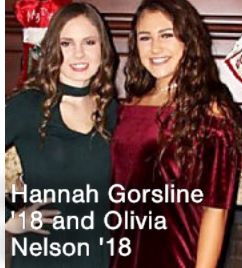

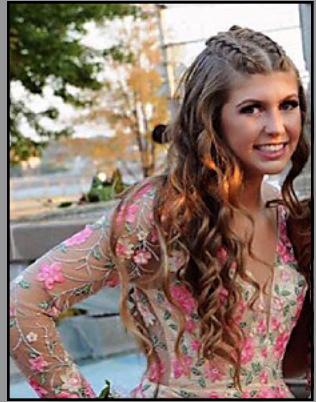

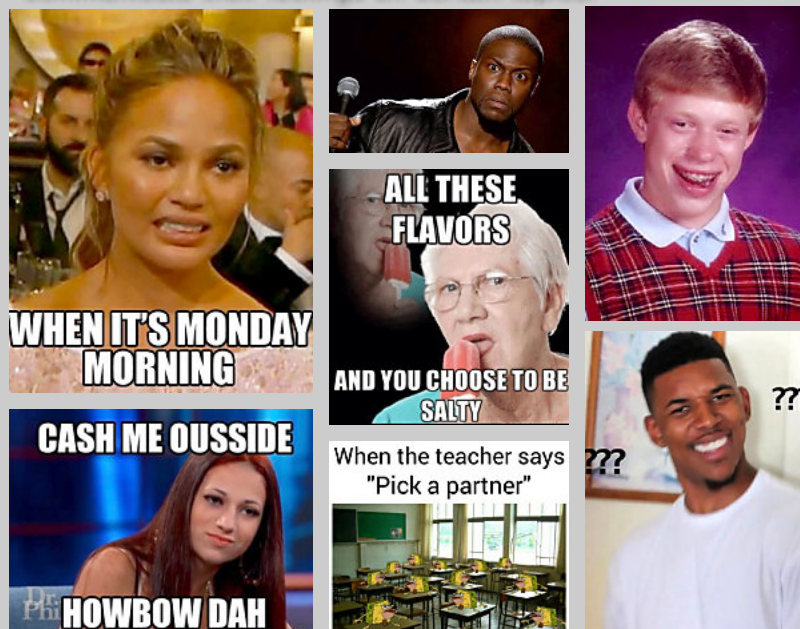

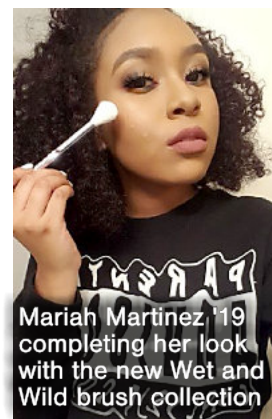

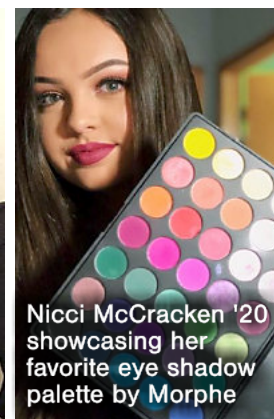

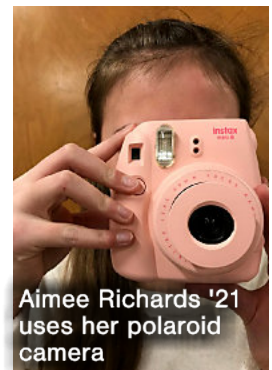
