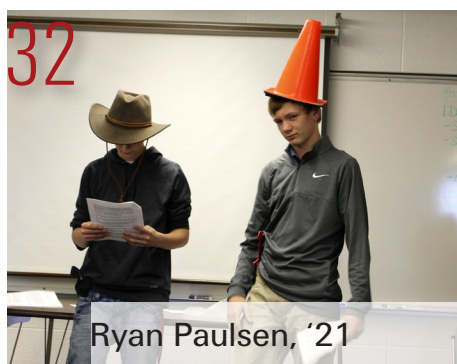

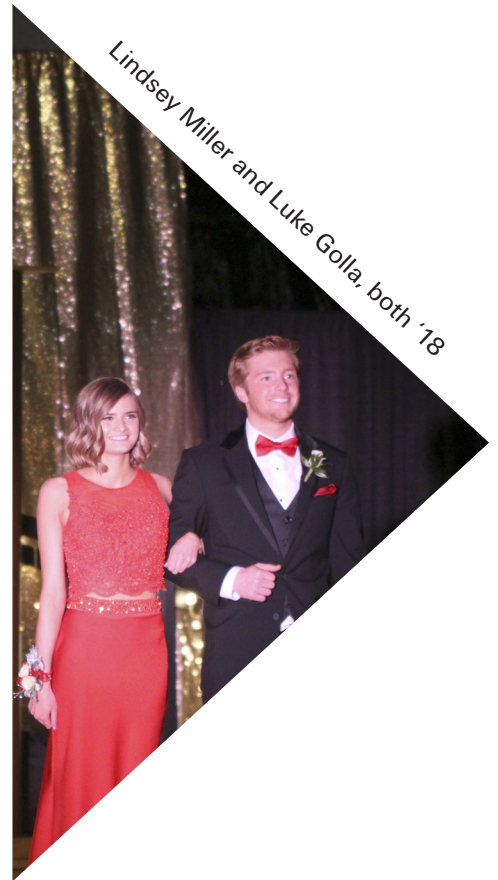

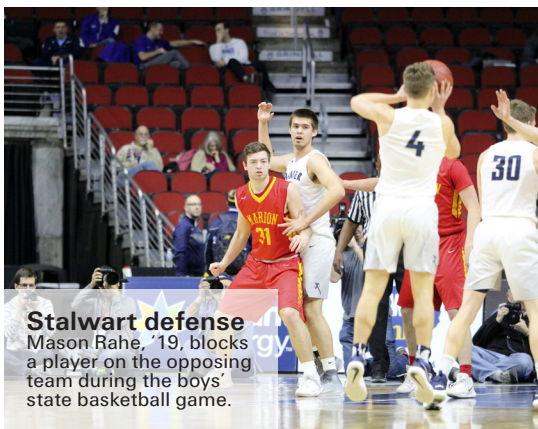

Gaven Hiler, '20, takes control of his opponent during a wrestling meet against Central City.



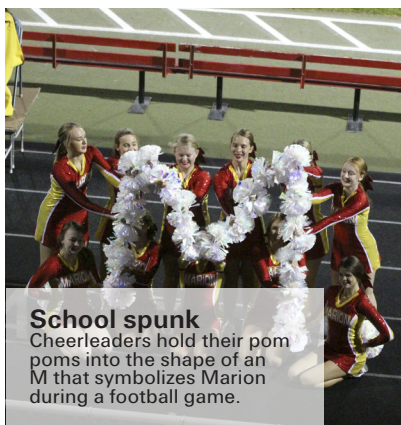

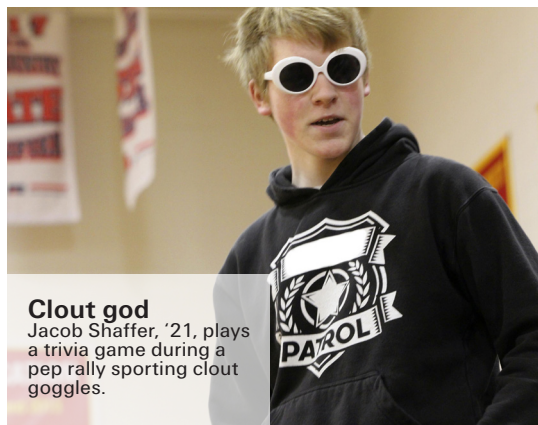
