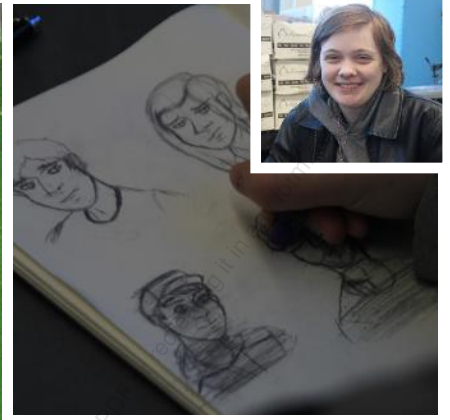
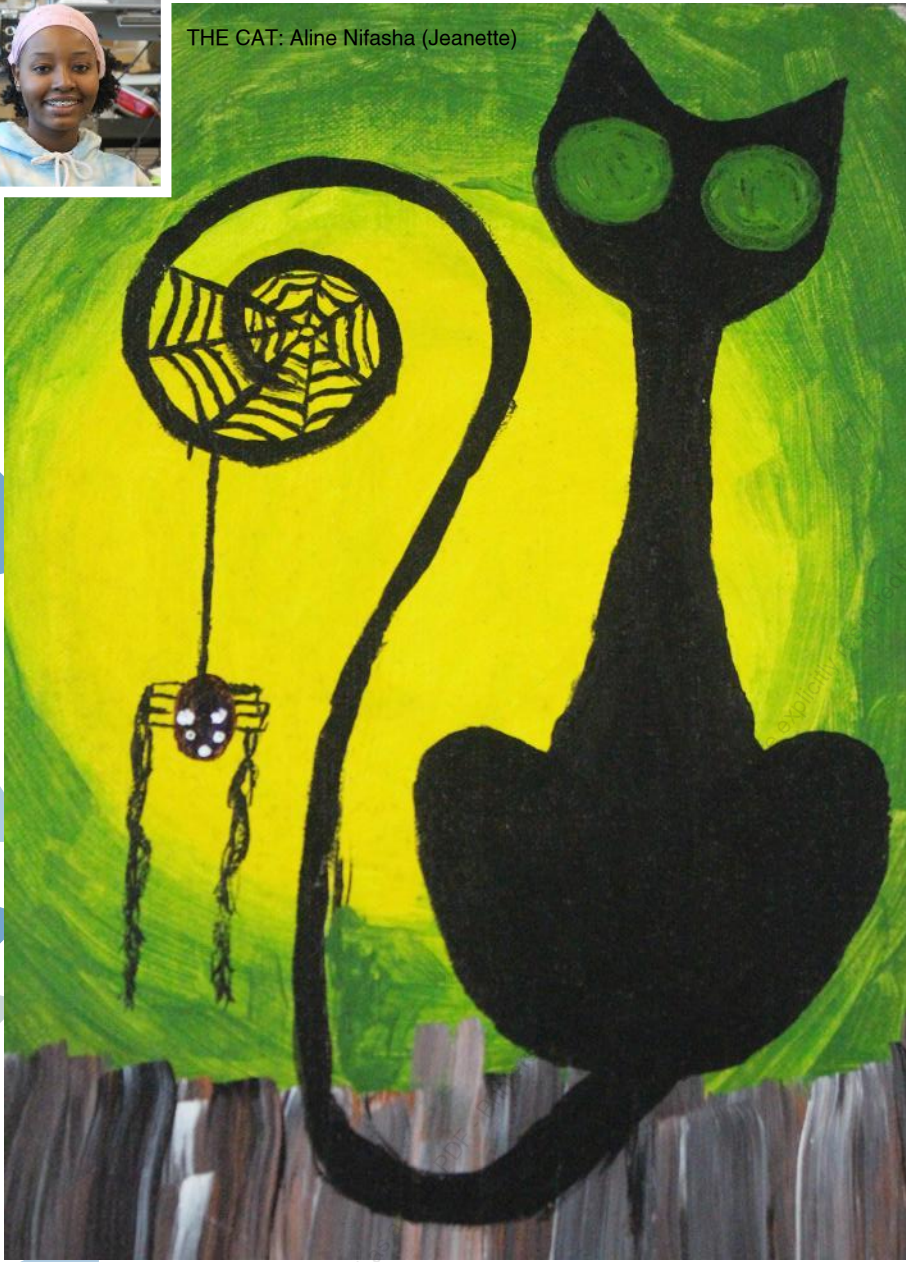

Q: Do you want art to be your career path?

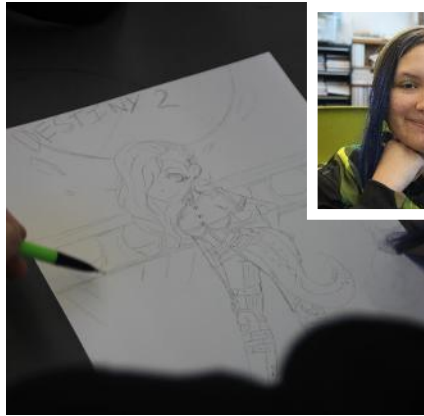
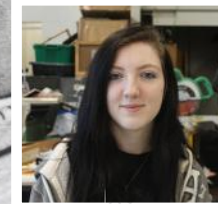
A: Definitely. I want to be an art therapist. I want to teach people how to put their feelings into art like I do.

A: It's like the person's soul is trapped inside them and they can't escape who they are. They don't want to be who they are, but you can't exactly change who you are.



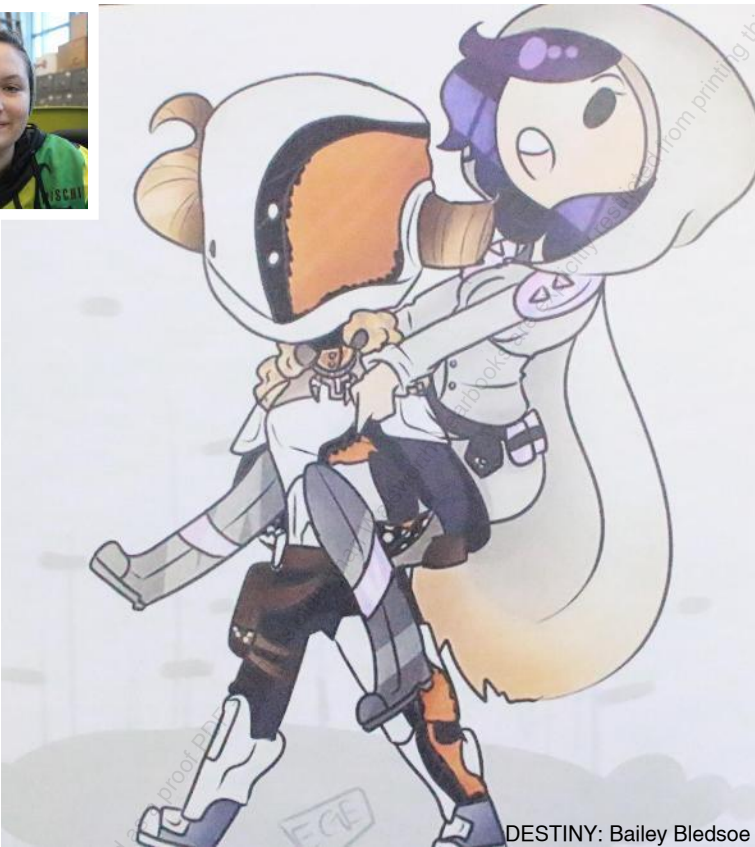
