

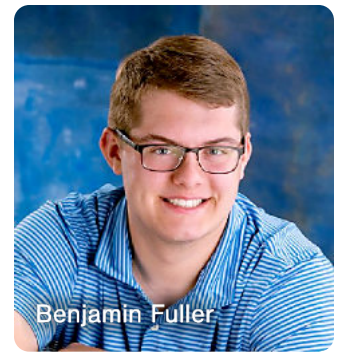


*Kalista Paxton*
