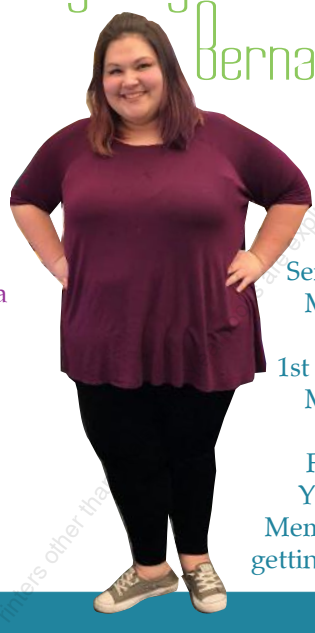

Blackhawk Volume 102, "It's About Time" was printed by Walsworth at Walsworth Publishing Company, 731 South Brunswick, Brookfield, MO, 64628. It was created at Central High School, 1120 Main Street, Davenport, IA 52803. It was created using Walsworth's Online Design and submitted through the program. Our yearbook representative was Jim Straub. The all-color book contains 176 pages and 450 books were printed. The cost of the book was \$65 at registration and then the book price rose to \$75; the price then went to \$85. The cover was designed by the yearbook staff and Kallista Souther from Walsworth Creative Services and printed on black luminaire linen with a silver debossed hot foil and silk screened image. The pages were printed on Anthem Plus/Legend Gloss 100# stock. The font "Ebony" was used for the body and caption copy, "Goudy" was used for subheadings, "HighEmotions" was used for headlines and all three were used for miscellaneous copy. The cameras that were used this year were the EOS Rebel T6i and two Sony cameras. Carlson Creative Images took senior portraits as well as various group, club and team photos. LifeTouch Photography took underclassmen and staff portraits. The colors used were F1540 (Yellow), F3700 (Purple), F4430 (Blue), F4895 (Green) and Gray 5. Davenport Central is a member of NSPA and IHSPA.
