MOST WEST STUDENTS KNOW that popular destination off Highway 1 at Willow Creek Court, Dane's Dairy. An Iowa City tradition since 1960, Dane's offers delicious treats ranging from homemade soft-serve to the famous Dane bar. In 1952, John Dane opened a pasteurizing plant with 100 Holstein dairy cows and a dairy store, and Dane's was built off Highway 1, a two-lane highway in 1960. The store sold gallons of glass-bottled milk, butter, cream, eggs and 5-cent ice cream cones. After closing the pasteurizing plant, Dane's introduced Damon frozen yogurt, which reduced their milk sales and increased ice cream sales. Dane's moved three times before ending up at its current location. Donna, John's daughter, inherited the company in 2009. "Dane's Dairy is a fun place for families to come," she said. "Our employees enjoy making ice cream products for customers and working together ... We are pleased to be recognized as the best soft-serve restaurant in the state of Iowa this year."
