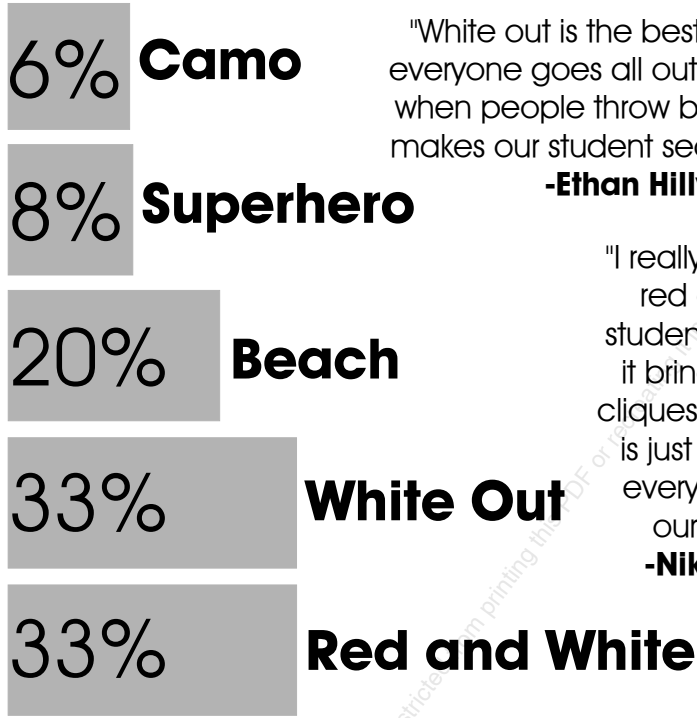


Loud And Proud "Jonah is always the most obnoxious at all of the volleyball games. I love it because it makes being a part of the student section more fun."
